



#### **ZONE-BASED OPTIONS DEVELOPMENT**

The Broken System has been divided into five zones, to consider the feasible reconfiguration options. Several individual options will apply across all of the zones. Other options (primarily infrastructure) will be unique to certain areas based on factors like, land and water use, and location within the system.

We look forward to sharing these draft options openly and widely in the coming months to ensure we have as many perspectives as possible to consider.
